The PEM Fellows require the **"Emergency Medical Pediatric Advances and Recent Therapeutics (EMPART)** completion certificate and not EMPACT Certificate.

Apart from the above faculty will have to give a written assurance that they have developed Competencies in procedures such as Central Lines insertion, IO Access in Pediatrics, Intubation, Chest Tubes, Lumbar Puncture, Pericardiocentesis, Pleural Tapping, Ascites Tapping, Eye & Slit Lamp Exam, Epistaxis Control, and Foreign Body Removal. Pelvic Exam, Tonometry Examinations are other procedures that faculty need to be trained for.

13. Proof that you are currently employed as teaching faculty (If you are one) in a MCI/NBE Recognized College/Hospital
14. The Registration Fee for the EMINDIA2019 can only be paid online at the Website
15. The Registration fee for Convocation has to be paid to ACEE by NEFT or Demand Draft in favour of ACEE payable at Delhi.
16. The One Time College Fellowship Fee for designated Fellows of the Academic College of Emergency Experts (FACEE) is INR 11,800 (including GST) which is to be paid separately by a Demand Draft made in Favor of ACEE or NEFT.
